

## 2011 Arafura Games Smoke Free Policy for Venues

### Smoke-Free Areas

In line with the Northern Territory Government's new smoke free legislation and the Arafura Games' commitment to providing a safe, comfortable and positive environment, the 2011 Arafura Games is a largely smoke free event.

However there will be clearly identified areas for people wishing to smoke.

To locate the designated smoking area at this venue, please refer to the venue map or ask a member of the Games Workforce for directions.

Please note:

- TIO Stadium is a smoke-free venue.
- Smoking is permitted only in clearly-signed and designated outdoor areas.
- Do not take food or drink into the designated smoking areas.
- Smoking is banned in the indoor areas of all sporting venues.
- No smoking is permitted within a two metre radius of an outdoor non-licensed food and drink area.
- You may be subject to an on-the-spot fine of \$110 if you are found smoking outside of a designated smoking area.
